 - 1.1 A letter, written by the applicant, outlining the reasons for requiring this financial assistance, the reasons for the proposed course of study and the intended use of the qualification.
 - 1.2 A character reference from a responsible officer of the Rural Women New Zealand Branch concerning the circumstances of the family and the need for assistance for the applicant's education.
 - 1.3 A character reference from a responsible citizen other than a teacher or member of the Rural Women New Zealand Branch.
 - 1.4 Proof of enrolment at University, Polytechnic or College for a full year's course.

NOTE 1: The above character references may be sent directly by the referee to Rural Women New Zealand, marked **Bursary/Confidential**.

NOTE 2: **If this application is accompanied by an application for either a Rural Women New Zealand Tertiary or Agricultural Bursary, only one set of supporting documents is required.**
- 2 Applications will be considered by the Bursary Committee of Rural Women New Zealand National Board at the next meeting. The decision of the Committee is final and all candidates will be notified of the results of their application.
- 3 Payment of the grant will be made to the applicant by 31 May.
- 4 The Text Book/Resource Grant is payable for one year only.
- 5 Any person meeting the criteria who is a New Zealand citizen is eligible to apply for this Bursary.
- 6 The decision of granting this Text Book/Resource Grant is final and no discussion will be entered into.
