YEAR 12 OR YEAR 13 BOARDING BURSARY

- 1 This application form must be accompanied by the following:
 - 1.1 A letter outlining the reasons for requiring this financial assistance, written by a parent or principal caregiver.
 - 1.2 A supporting letter from the principal or a current teacher.
 - 1.3 A character reference from a responsible Officer of the Rural Women New Zealand Branch, concerning the circumstances of the family and the need for assistance in educating the applicant.
 - 1.4 A character reference from a responsible citizen other than a teacher or member of the Rural Women New Zealand Branch.

NOTE: The above character references may be sent directly by the referee to Rural Women New Zealand marked ***Bursary/Confidential***.
- 2 The application is to be received by Rural Women New Zealand, P O Box 12-021, Wellington, by **30 September**.
- 3 Applications will be considered by the Bursary Committee of Rural Women New Zealand at the November meeting. The decision of the Committee is final and all candidates will be notified of the results of their application by 30 November.
- 4 Payment of the Bursary will be made by April, once confirmation of the applicant's enrolment at the secondary school has been received. Payment will be made direct to the principal caregiver, who must advise Rural Women New Zealand National Office immediately if the applicant leaves school or no longer boards away from home. A proportional refund of the Bursary may be required.
- 5 The Bursary is payable for one year only. At the end of the year, a report on the applicant's progress at school is to be sent to Rural Women New Zealand National Office.
- 6 Any student meeting the criteria, who is a New Zealand citizen, is eligible to apply for this Bursary.
- 7 All decisions by the National Board of Rural Women New Zealand will be final and no discussion will be entered.
