PURPOSE

Grants are directed towards Ministry of Education registered community based co-operative play groups for vulnerable and remotely located children in rural Hunterville and Ruahine areas.

VALUE

Two grants of up to \$3,000 each will be made each year until all funds are used. A group may apply more than once. Payments will be made in by 31st March.

CRITERIA

Grants will be made available to:

- any Ministry of Education registered playgroup in the catchment of the former mobile kindergarten
- meet any funding shortfalls for an early childhood educator
- upgrade facilities to meet Ministry of Education standards and building warrant of fitness
- start a new Ministry of Education registered playgroup
- any playgroup requiring additional services to meet the children's educational needs such as a specialist teacher or adapting a building for children with disabilities as required

The applicant will need to indicate the benefit of the grant to the children

- the application will be treated as confidential and subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act
