



## Korokipo Branch Agricultural/Horticultural Tertiary Bursary

The purpose of the bursary is to encourage residents of Hawke's Bay to undertake further education or training in land based courses either through university or polytechnics. It is hoped that bursary recipients will ultimately seek employment in Hawke's Bay so the benefits of their learning can be passed on to the Hawke's Bay community and its industries.

- The bursary is open to a New Zealand citizen resident in the Hawke's Bay District. The Hawkes Bay District encompasses those who live within the boundaries of Wairoa District, Hastings District, Napier City, or Central Hawkes Bay District.
- Agricultural and Horticulture courses include agriculture, aqua-farming, bee keeping, horticulture, silviculture, veterinary and viticulture.
- The bursary is to be used for course fees, text books, online resources or other related course costs.
- Applicants will have already completed their first year of study. The course of study must be full time.
- The value of the bursary is at the discretion of the RWNZ Korokipo Branch Tertiary Bursary Committee with no one bursary exceeding \$2,000.
  - The bursary is only for one year.
  - Applicants will be required to attend an interview.
  - Decisions made by the committee are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Should your application be successful, bursary funds will be direct credited to your bank account no later than 1 March.
- All information on this application is confidential. It will be kept only for the purpose for which it was collected and it will not be used of other purposes.
- The closing date for applications is **15 January**.
