



## Brunswick Beanie:

≈ 50g - 90g [100 - 200m] DK Yarn  
 4.00mm circular needle [40cm/16"]  
 4.00mm double point needles for crown  
 Stitch markers, Tapestry needle

**Sizes: S / M / L / XL:**

*Snuggly and head hugging, fits a wide range of sizes*  
 Unstretched [32 / 36 / 40 / 44cm] / [12.5 / 14 / 15.5 / 17"]  
 Stretched up to ≈ [46 / 50 / 56 / 61cm] / [18 / 20 / 22 / 24"]

**Gauge:** 22 stitches and 30 rows to 10cm/4"  
 over stocking stitch using 4.00mm needles

### Instructions:

Using 4.00mm needles cast on 90 / 100 / 110 / 120 sts  
*You need to work a stretchy cast on - German  
 twisted cast on or tubular cast on recommended*

Join to work in the round. Place marker.

Work in P1, K1 rib until knitting measures:  
 ≈ 14 / 15 / 16 / 16cm [5.5 / 6 / 6.5 / 6.5"] from cast on  
 or length desired (*longer will be slouchier*)

**Crown:** Place marker every 18 / 20 / 22 / 24sts

R1) \* Work in P1, K1 rib until 3 sts before marker,  
 CDD (sl2, k1, p2sso); rep from \* to end  
*Total of 10 sts decreased per round*

R2) Work in P1, K1 rib without decreasing  
 Repeat R1 & R2 until 20 sts remain

Last round: \*K2tog; rep from \* to end of round  
*Total of 10sts remain*

### Abbreviations:

K	Knit
P	Purl
K2tog	Knit 2 sts together
Knit wise	As if to knit
PSSO	Pass slipped stitch over
P2SSO	Pass 2 slipped stitches over
SI	Slip stitch
CDD	Centred double decrease: [Slip 2 sts knit wise, k1, p2sso]
