

Coburg Cowl:



A quick and snugly cowl, written for 2 sizes and 4 weights of yarn, but easy to resize by changing the number of stitches (pattern is a multiple of 4 sts.)

Sizes: M-L, [L-XL]
Circumference ≈ 61cm / 24", [71cm / 28"]
Height: 9" / 23cm

DK / 8ply Yarn ≈ 120g [240m]
 4.00mm circular needle [60cm/24"]
 22 sts to 10cm / 4" on 4.00mm needles

Aran / Worsted / 10ply Yarn ≈ 140g [210m]
 5.00mm circular needle [60cm/24"]
 19 sts to 10cm / 4" on 5.00mm needles

Bulky / 12ply Yarn ≈ 150g [203m]
 5.50mm circular needle [60cm/24"]
 16 sts to 10cm/4" on 5.50mm needles

Super Bulky / 16ply Yarn ≈ 160g [160m]
 6.50mm circular needle [60cm/24"]
 13.5 sts to 10cm/4" on 6.50mm needles

Tapestry needle, stitch marker

Instructions:

| DK / 8ply | Aran / Worsted / 10ply | Bulky / 12ply | Super Bulky / 16ply |
|---|--|--|---|
| With 4.00mm needle cast on 132 / 152 sts | With 5.00mm needle cast on 112 / 132sts | With 5.50mm needle cast on 96 / 112 sts | With 6.50mm needle cast on 80 / 92 sts |

All sizes: Join work into round. Place marker to note start of round. Work 5 rows of garter stitch edging:

R1, 3, 5) Purl all sts

R2, 4) Knit all sts

Work in Garter Rib Pattern until work measures approx.:

| DK / 8ply | Aran / Worsted / 10ply | Bulky / 12ply | Super Bulky / 16ply |
|------------------|------------------------|-----------------|---------------------|
| 8.5" / 21.5cm | 8.5" / 21.5cm | 8.25" / 21cm | 8.25" / 21cm |

from cast on edge, finishing with round 2 (knit all sts).

Repeat R1 – R4) of garter stitch edging.

Cast off loosely, purlwise.

Suspended cast off or other loose cast off recommended.

Sew in ends.

Garter Rib Pattern:

R1) * K2, P2: repeat from * to end of round

R2) K all stitches

Repeat rounds 1 & 2

Purlwise Suspended Cast Off

1) Purl 2 sts

2) With left needle, pass 1st st on right needle over 2nd st & leave on *left* needle

3) Purl next st from left needle

4) Slip both stitches from left needle

Repeat 2-4
