

Wrist Warmer Knitting Patterns

Wool - Skeinz Southlander DK www.skeinze.com

Needles - 4mm (UK sz 8)

Pasture

Cast on 36 stitches (42 stitches for large size)

Knit garter stitch for 8 rows [RS – K, WS – K]

Knit stocking stitch until work measures 15cm [RS – K, WS – P]

Cast off with right side facing.

Furrow

Cast on 38 stitches (42 stitches for large size)

Knit garter stitch for 8 rows [RS – K, WS – K]

Row 1 - RS – K

Row 2 - WS – [p2, k2] repeat to the end

Continue working these two rows until work measures 15cm.

Cast off with right side facing.

Landscape

Cast on 38 stitches (44 stitches for large size)

Knit garter stitch for 8 rows [RS – K, WS – K]

Row 1 – K1, [k2tog tbs, Kfb] repeat to last stitch, K1

Row 2 – P

Row 3 – K1 [Kfb, K2tog tbs] repeat to last stitch, K1

Row 4 – P

Continue rows 1 to 4 until work measures 15cm.

Cast off with right side facing.

Muster

Cast on 36 stitches (42 stitches for large size)

Knit garter stitch for 8 rows [RS – K, WS – K]

Row 1 – K

Row 2 – P

Row 3 – [P3, K3] repeat to end

Row 4 – P

Row 5 – K

Row 6 – P

Row 7 – [K3, P3] repeat to the end

Row 8 – P

Row 9 – K

Row 10 – P

Continue working patten as above until work measures 15cm.

Cast off with right side facing.

How to sew up

Hold or pin right sides together. Use a darning or wool needle to sew from both the top down and the bottom up leaving a space open for the thumb.

Abbreviations

RS right side

WS wrong side

K knit

P purl

K2tog knit 2 stitches together

tbs through back of stitches

Kfb increase by knitting through front and back of stitch
