Purpose

The Virbac New Zealand Rural Women New Zealand Animal Health Graduate Grant is available to veterinary or veterinary nurse graduates who are seeking employment or have been employed to work and live in smaller centres or rural areas of New Zealand.

The grant is intended to provide support and/or assist the recipient/s who is/are starting their career and new life in their chosen small centre or rural community.

Value: A grant of up to \$1,500 will be awarded to the successful applicant/s.

Eligibility

- You must be a New Zealand citizen/resident to apply for this grant.
- The applicant must have recently completed studies in veterinary or veterinary nursing and have graduated from a recognised New Zealand education provider.
- Preference will be given to those who are seeking employment or have been employed to work and live in smaller centres or rural areas.

Applications

- Applications must be made on the official Virbac Rural Women New Zealand Animal Health Grant application form to the National Office of Rural Women New Zealand.
- Applications are considered by a committee made up of two Rural Women New Zealand representatives as well as a representative from Virbac New Zealand Ltd, at a meeting scheduled after the closing date for applications on 31 March 2021.
- All applications will be acknowledged upon receipt.
- You will be notified of the decision which will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The application will be treated as confidential and subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act.
- The committee reserves the right to seek a report from you on how you utilised the Grant and what benefits you experienced as a result.
