



Diamond Jubilee Agricultural Tertiary Bursary

Bursary Regulations

Focus:

Students undertaking a full-time course of at least one year in an agricultural subject. This includes related studies such as horticulture, veterinary, bee keeping, aqua farming and viticulture.

Value and Tenure:

\$1,000 for 1 year. Can be applied for up to two times per applicant.

Eligibility:

Applicants must:

- be an NZ citizen
- a tertiary student enrolled in a full-year course
- courses must be in an agriculture-related area of study.

Selection Committee:

This Bursary is awarded by the Rural Women New Zealand Bursary Committee consisting of appointed members by the National Board of Rural Women New Zealand.

Factors such as financial need, the reasons for the course of study, and the intended use of the qualification are taken into consideration when awarding this bursary



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Application Checklist:

- a letter written by the applicant outlining the reasons for requiring financial assistance, the reasons for the proposed course of study and the intended use of the qualification
- a copy of the previous year's study results or the last school report (if within three years), or an academic reference
- character reference from a member of Rural Women New Zealand, outlining the need for assistance
- character reference from another responsible citizen (non-family member), from someone who is known to the applicant
- proof of enrolment in the proposed course of study

Selection Considerations:

Applications will be acknowledged by the National Office upon receipt.

Applications will be treated as confidential and are subject to the provisions of the Privacy Act.

Applicants who are granted a Bursary and withdraw from full-time study before the end of the academic year, may be obliged to refund the whole or part of the Bursary as determined by the Rural Women New Zealand National Board.
